





Cavalier

A standout piece in the collection is the mid-length pencil skirt, adorned with staggering leather fringing that adds a dynamic sense of movement, reminiscent of the powerful stride of a horse. This element, a nod to the rustic charm of the countryside, evokes the essence of a free-spirited lifestyle. The fitted bodice, intricately adorned with alpaca hair, mirrors the texture and flow of a horse's mane, creating a tactile connection to the animal's natural beauty. The inclusion of conventional horse bits, typically used to guide a horse's directional movements, adds a symbolic layer, blending utility with style and bringing unconventional elements into the fashion narrative. These signature motifs—the horse's mane and bits—underscore the collection's innovative approach to integrating equestrian influences in a refined and sophisticated manner.

Drawing inspiration from the Antonio Marras Pre-Fall 2024 collection, "Cavalier" echoes the rugged yet polished aesthetic of a Midwestern cowboy, where the use of leather fringing becomes a focal point, capturing the raw, untamed spirit of the American West. This element of design hones in on the identifiable features of a cowboy, while the use of alpaca fur creates a direct link to the horse, celebrating its natural beauty. The design carefully balances the external beauty and internal strength of the horse, encapsulating the animal's dual nature as both a powerful force and a graceful creature. This duality is reflected in the collection's design ethos, where strength meets elegance, and tradition meets innovation.


